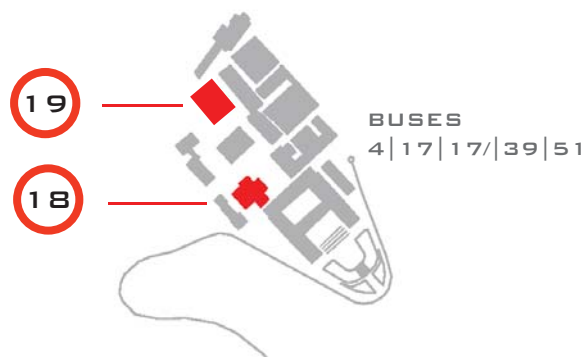

19 June sessions are open to all University of Trieste students.



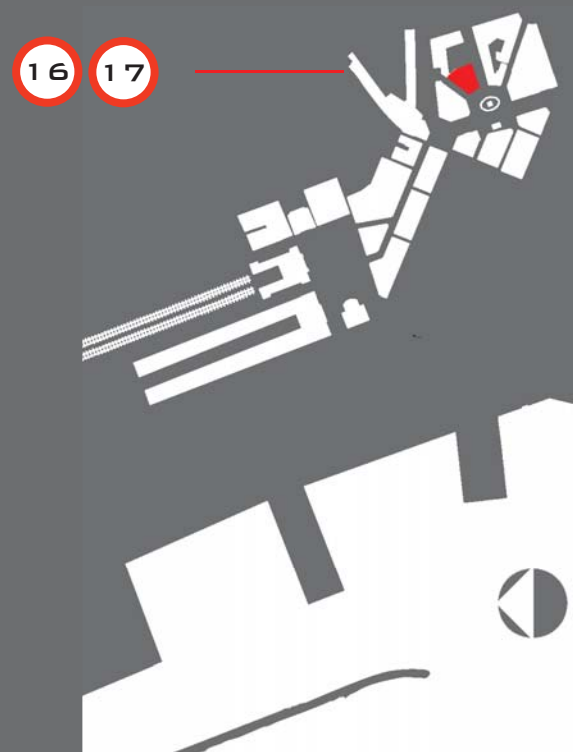
